

Problem Drivers: Bucks County:

Problem Driver #1 - High number of youth entering placement (ages 13-17) because of child behavioral problems

Related to Outcome Measures: A, B, C, D

Problem Driver #2 - Number of children who remain in care beyond 12 months

Related to Outcome Measures: A, B, D, E, F, H

Problem Driver #3 - Number of children entering placement due to parental substance addiction

Related to Outcome Measures: D, E, F

Problem Driver #4 – High number of children who are reunified but reenter care within 12 months

Related to Outcome Measures: A, B, D

Problem Driver #5 – High number of children in congregate care

Related to Outcome Measures: A, B, D, F

Problem Driver #6 – High number of children who move to permanency after an extensive period of time in the foster care system or age out of the system
